

Folkert Scholarship Guidelines

1. Art Reach of Mid Michigan is offering a scholarship to Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp in memory of Kendall Folkert. This partial scholarship for one two-week summer session in fine or visual arts is open to any student who will be entering the ninth grade the following fall. The applicant should demonstrate enthusiasm and talent in instrumental music, choir, theatre, dance or visual arts. Formal training or outstanding work in the areas of interest is not necessary.
2. The format for receiving a scholarship award will be a letter or recommendation from a fine arts instructor, a one page (or less) essay written by the applicant about why he/she would be a good candidate for the Blue Lake Scholarship, completion, in full, of the official Blue Lake application (available at www.bluelake.com) and an interview by the Art Reach Scholarship Committee. Interviews will be scheduled within one week of the application deadline.
3. It is fully understood that when a student is selected, a health form (required by the state) will be completed and further endorsements by the parents and teachers will be necessary to complete registration.
4. The 2007 scholarship award will be in the amount of \$500 and is funded by Art Reach of Mid Michigan and the General Federation of Women's Clubs, Mt. Pleasant (GFWC).
5. All applicants will be notified as soon as possible by mail and/or phone as to their standing in the scholarship award. One student will be selected as the scholarship recipient, with an alternate chosen in case the original recipient cannot attend their selected session.
6. Completed information must be submitted by 5 p.m. on the deadline date (April 18, 2008) to Folkert Scholarship, Art Reach of Mid Michigan, P.O. Box 166, 319 S. University, Mt. Pleasant MI 48804-0166.
